Meadowlands Fishing Permit Issue

- 1. Fifteen Meadowlands fishing permits are issued in the first week in August (Meadowlands rule).
- 2. All resident permits are issued at the discretion of the Clerk.
- 3. Residents can apply to be on the fishing permit list at any time.
- 4. All residents on the list at the beginning of June, existing and new, are considered for a permit each year.
- 5. If the total number of residents on the list exceeds the number of permits available then the permits will be rotated fairly round the list (so those who have had a permit the longest are not given a permit this time).
- 6. Permit holders who do not get a permit for the following year are invited to request to go back onto the list for next year. Note they do have to make a formal application.

This Policy was adopted on 1st April 2015
